

# From My Heart...

On an ESPN biography of Vince Lombardi, one of his assistants said something like this about the great coach: "Lombardi didn't think you started playing the game on Sunday. His idea was that you started playing the game earlier in the week, on Monday or Tuesday, with the process of preparation."

It's the same way in the ministry. Great churches spend all week getting ready for Sunday; great preachers spend all week getting ready to preach the Word of God. I have found that I am most effective in ministry, whether it's teaching from the pulpit or leading worship, when I spend the entire week focused on what God has called me to do on Sunday morning.

We all have a million obligations Monday through Friday...visits, meetings and emergencies and they must be attended to. But for me as the pastor, and for our church, we can't allow ourselves to lose sight of the importance of Sunday. This week, for 80 percent of the people in this place today, this is the only time you will see each other. Sunday needs to be good, I need to have a word from God that will meet your needs.

In 1 Corinthians 9 Paul said, "I do not run like a man running aimlessly; I do not fight like a man beating the air." Moments before, he said, "I do all this for the sake of the gospel." He lived and breathed preparation and focus.

We have heard the "trash talk" this week between the two Super Bowl teams. When they're talking trash, they are distracted from preparing! Just like teams can get distracted by what happens off the field, we can lose focus too.

I challenge you not to lose sight of the importance of the time we spend together in Bible Study and worship on the Lord's Day. Spend every day this week focused on preparing for what God wants to do through you next Sunday.

I hope you'll be someplace with Woodland Hills people tonight. Either at your Life Groups Fellowship, or join us at Jason's Deli for food, fellowship, testimonies and music.
