Early voting has been going on this week and will continue through Friday, March 2. You can check the papers or websites to find out where you can vote. If you are not registered, it's too late for you to register and vote this time...but you need to register now so you will be eligible to vote at the next election.

Then election day is Tuesday, March 6. I believe it is the duty of every Christian to vote. And I believe also, it's the duty of every Christian to vote for leaders who have and promote Christian values. Because of that, and I am speaking just for myself, I'm not nearly as interested in a persons economic outlook as I am that persons moral and Biblical outlook.

You can't pick up a paper, turn on a radio or TV and not be aware that the grip of sin is all around us. I know theologically that we all have a sin nature, and we are under a curse. But I really believe many of the problems we have in America is because of godless leadership. I believe now is the time to choose leaders who will be themselves led by the Lord and who have pro-Christian principles. I can't support leaders that violate the Bible's commands for life, family, marriage, or faith.

Christians in many countries in this world are oppressed and persecuted. They suffer under governments they are powerless to change and governments that hate their faith and silence their voices. I thank God for America, where we have the opportunity to go to the voting booth and vote our convictions. Our missionaries serve in many countries where Christ is thrown completely out of all activities. Some even to the point of being persecuted and killed for trying to make Godly changes.

So please, join me in praying, then join me in voting!
