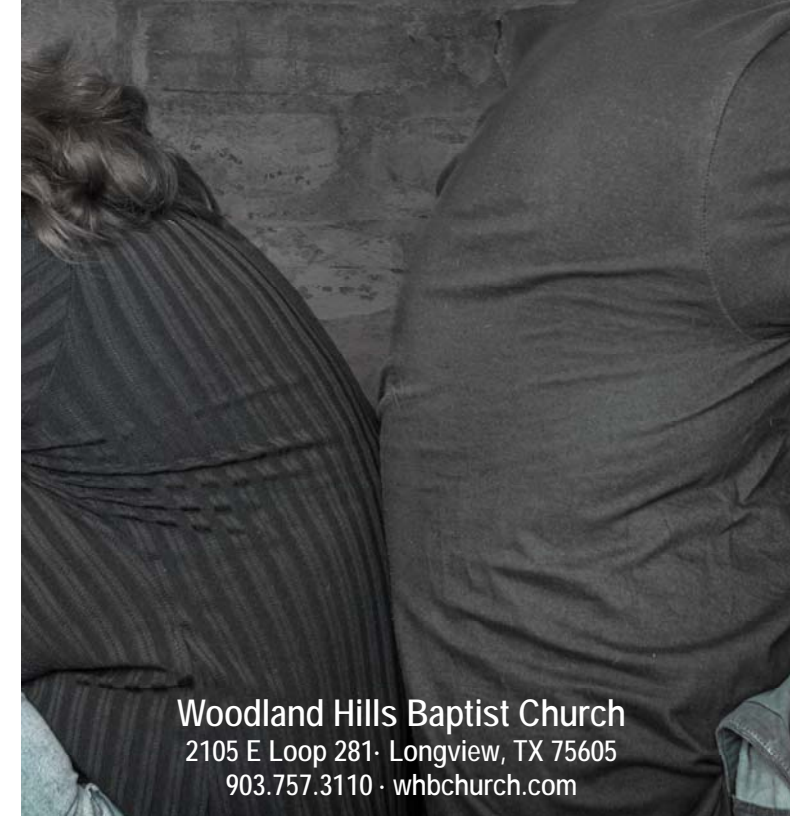

From My Heart...



William James said, "The greatest use of life is to spend it for something that will outlast us." Most of the things we do in a given day are temporary. Driving here or there...Having a meal...Watching TV...Playing softball. Even at work, what we do is more often about fixing the problems we had yesterday than realizing tomorrow's dreams.

So how do we bring a sense of the eternal into each day? How do we ensure we spend our lives building something that will outlast our time here on earth?

There are only two things that last forever...

- The Word of God
- People

If you want to build something in your life that will last, look for ways to connect these two. Look for ways to speak God's word into the lives of others. This involves more than quoting Bible verses -- though that is certainly part of it. It involves bringing the presence of God into every conversation.

We live in a time when almost every person we come in contact with every day is facing something serious. Some people have just figured out how to hide it better than others. It may be relationship problems with a spouse, it may be an illness, it may be rebellious kids and not knowing what to do, it may be financial strains or problems at work. It may take only a sentence or two, but every time you do this you'll be building something that will last for all eternity.
