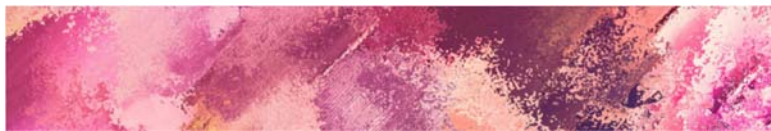

From My Heart...



Our Building Team is doing a wonderful job on our new building. This is a report almost like some of the "stuff" our Building Team has faced. Yet they are moving on for the glory of God!

In the year 2018, the Lord came unto Noah, who was now living in the United States, and said, "Once again, the earth has become wicked and over-populated and I see the end of all flesh before me. Build another Ark and save two of every living thing along with a few good humans." He gave Noah the blueprints, saying, "You have six months to build the Ark before I will start the unending rain for 40 days and 40 nights". Six months later, the Lord looked down and saw Noah weeping in his yard ... but no ark.
