From My Heart...



What do you think is one of the main reasons people are not interested in going to church to hear the Gospel? Many of them went to church at one time and were used and unappreciated or got in the middle of a big fight over next to nothing. They experienced too much religion and not enough Christ-likeness; too much power of man and not enough calling on the power of the Holy Spirit. One of the greatest detriments to Christianity can be Christians who do not act like Christ.

On the other hand, one of the most attractive things about Christianity is a transformed life. When you meet a person who was blind spiritually and now can see, a person who knows they were saved from a dead end existence, you want to know what it was they found! Of course, the root of that difference is in your personal relationship with Christ. It is getting to know Him. It is that excitement that comes from relationship, not just the knowledge of religion.

This is the difference between the Tree of Life, and the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil. The Tree of Life is life giving, drawing us to Christ. The Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil is fault finding and condemning. It drives people away in fear of losing their freedoms or rights. Let me state that I don't believe that those trees main representations fit these descriptions, but I do believe we can use them as an analogy for attitudes of the heart.

God has called us to be lifeguards, not umpires. Many living in the tree of the knowledge of good and evil are convinced they are doing the right thing, the godly thing. But they've lost sight of the goal of Christ-likeness. He came to seek and save the lost, not seek and destroy the lost.

I'm asking every member of Woodland Hills to join me during the remainder of the summer to live according to the Tree of Life.

My prayer and goal is to see 100 souls be saved during the summer. Impossible? It will be at the rate we are going and have gone. But if we will begin to think about the souls of man and remember that we're not here to judge and be umpires, but rather to be a lifeguard and save a soul from hell, it can be done.
