Rusty Stevens, a director for the Navigators, shares his story. "As I feverishly pushed the lawn mower around our yard, I wondered if I'd finish before dinner. Mikey, our 6-year-old, walked up and, without even asking, stepped in front of me and placed his hands on the mower handle. Knowing that he wanted to help me, I quit pushing.

The mower quickly slowed to a stop. Chuckling inwardly at his struggles, I resisted the urge to say, "Get out of here, kid. You're in my way." and said instead, "Here, Son. I'll help you." As I resumed pushing, I bowed my head back and leaned forward, and walked spread-legged to avoid colliding with Mikey.
