## From My Heart....



In Isaiah 6:8, the man of God said, "Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, Whom shall I send, and who will go for us? Then said I, Here am I; send me."

I read about a very tough college football coach who liked to give his players mental workouts by quizzing them on what they would do during hypothetical situations. He would regularly roam the sidelines...get in a player's face and scream "what would you do if?" One day walking the sidelines he stopped a player and barked out, "Johnson! If it were 3rd and 25, and we were at midfield, what would you do?"

The player thought for a moment and then said, "I would move down to the next bench to get a better view of the play." That is a pretty good example that he spends a lot of time on the bench!

God doesn't ask anyone to sit on the bench. In fact, we are instructed not to. You can't win sitting on the sidelines; get in the game and play.

Our attitude ought to be "put me in coach! Put me in!" It's also the same attitude we see in Isaiah. When God said, "Whom shall I send? Who will go for us?" Isaiah responded, "Here am I. Send me!" He was saying, "Put me in coach." I challenge you to say the same thing today.

There is so much to do in the Kingdom of God, and there is plenty of work to go around for everyone! It may be working in Sunday School, Music, Youth, Children's Ministry, Celebrate Recovery, Driving or riding a bus, Visitation, Discipleship, Missions, and I could go on and on. We need helpers to carry out the Great Commission. This is no day to be sitting on the bench trying to see what's going on...get up and get on the field!

Whatever you do, DO NOT MISS MONDAY NIGHT! Dr. Fred Luter will bless your heart and encourage you greatly. You'll leave tomorrow night saying..."It's been good to be in the House of the Lord!"

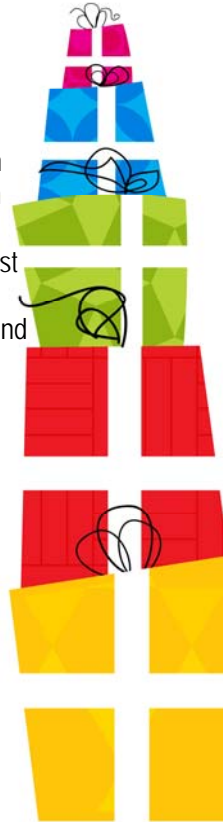
