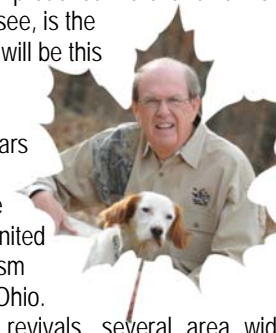


WELCOME DR. DON WHITT
