From My Heart....

As believers, it's easy to fall into the mindset of trying to please God through our actions, thinking that by doing good works or following certain rules, we can earn His favor. But scripture reminds us that God desires trust over striving for approval. Hebrews 11:6

says, "And without faith, it is impossible to please God because anyone who comes to Him must believe that He exists and that He rewards those who earnestly seek Him." The foundation of our relationship with God is faith—trusting in His goodness, grace, and promises.

In John 6:28-29, when the people asked Jesus what works God required, He responded, "The work of God is this: to believe in the one He has sent." Jesus shifted their focus from trying to earn God's approval to simply trusting in Him. Trusting God means resting in the assurance that His love is not based on our performance but on His faithfulness.

A thought-provoking question to consider: Are we living as though God's love needs to be earned, or are we living in the freedom of trusting Him completely? Trust transforms our relationship with God—it moves us from striving to resting in His grace, knowing that His approval comes not from what we do but from what Christ has already done for us.
