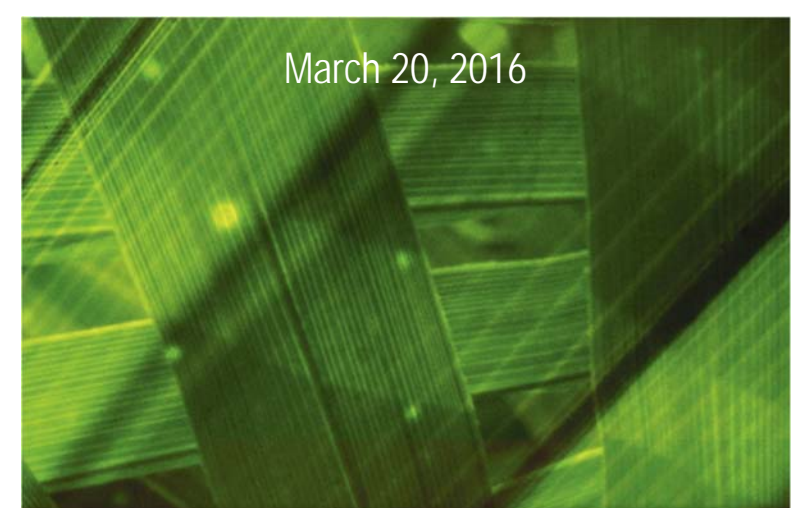

"Now if we be dead with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him: knowing that Christ being raised from the dead dieth no more; death hath no more dominion over him. For in that he died, he died unto sin once: but in that he liveth, he liveth unto God. Likewise reckon ye also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord."-Romans 6:8-11

The apostles spent their entire lives living from the simple facts of the gospel. The life of Christ, the death of Christ, the resurrection, ascension, and the second coming of Christ. This is what their entire life was about.

John Newton said in the mid 1700's, "that the two pillars of our religion are, the work of Christ for us, and his work in us by the Holy Spirit."

That's what Easter is all about...the simplicity of the gospel. What are you doing with it...or what are you doing about it?
