From My Heart...



The short phrase, “four-letter word,” has come to mean a crude curse word. Those words are deemed offensive to many people.

I’m not sure how many four-letter words are actually on a list, but I have a four-letter word that a lot of “church people” might want to add to the list. And you know what? It is one of the most important words in the Bible. And get this—the word actually came out of the mouth of Jesus!

The passage is the Great Commission— “Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to **obey** everything I have commanded you.” (Matthew 28:19-20) Can you believe it! Jesus used the four-letter word ... “obey.” “Oh come on,” you may be thinking, “obey” isn’t the bad kind of four-letter word.” I would disagree, at least by the way we often treat it. What Jesus said was that to make disciples, we have to teach people to obey the things he commanded. And on the flip side, to be his disciples we have to obey his commandments.

“What’s the big deal about that?” The big deal is that we are a whole lot better at knowing the teachings and commands of Jesus than we are at obeying them. I don’t think I am just talking about me, am I? We know Jesus said to love our neighbors as ourselves (Matthew 22:39); we just don’t always do it. We know that we are supposed to seek his kingdom and righteousness first and not worry about the smaller things of life (Matthew 6:25-33), but we sure get anxious about and work hard for the things of the world. We know that there is a great need for Christians to share the faith with those who are lost (Matthew 9:36-38), but we keep our mouths shut much of the time. We know that we are to go to the ends of the earth (Acts 1:8), but we stay put in front of our TVs and computers for an inordinate amount of time.

In Matthew 7:24-27, it is recorded that Jesus said the difference in building a house (life) that will not crash in the storms is the difference in knowing his words and knowing and doing (obeying) them. Where are you being challenged in your life? Where are you feeling guilty? Where do you need to grow the most? I would be willing to bet that those may be the places where obedience is being called for, but we just aren’t giving it. Let me challenge us all to do a side-by-side comparison of “what we know we are supposed to be doing as followers of Christ” and “what we are actually doing.” Then start obeying!




