In 2006, Alitalia Airlines made a slight mistake on its website. They advertised business-class seats from Toronto to Cyprus for \$39. That was a great deal for the customers who bought up over 2,000 tickets! It was not however a great deal for the airline. The price of that flight was supposed to be \$3900 per ticket not \$39.
