From My Heart...



My daddy took a rough, grown up thicket in East Texas and made it into a beautiful home site with beautiful green pastures, a wonderful garden spot that could grow anything from peanuts and sugar cane to peas, corn and tomatoes.

After removing untold numbers of trees and brush, (we didn't use chain saws...we used cross cut hand saws!) he planted new trees and grass, and kept it watered. It was always mowed and kept in good shape.

I went by the old home place not long ago. It has lacked my daddy's consistent care. When I visited and looked around that house, I saw thistles, thorns, and weeds. The underbrush has grown up again and no longer is the pasture beautiful and green. Where the garden spot was, it is so grown up and thick you can't even walk through it.

There is a spiritual aspect of this in my heart. Am I like that neglected yard, or perhaps the field and vineyard described in Proverbs 24 - overgrown with thorns, covered with nettles, its stone wall broken down? (v.31). The owner is lazy and lacks understanding (v.30), perhaps putting off today's tasks for a more convenient time.

Along with the practical instruction about diligence in work, I find an application for the care of my soul. The thistles of self-interest grow naturally within me, while the fruit that pleases God requires constant weeding and watering through prayer, confession, and obedience to the Lord. Without these, the soil of my heart will become choked with the thorns of trivial pursuits and greed.

"Keep your heart with all diligence," Solomon wrote, *"for out of it spring the issues of life"* (Proverbs 4:23). That requires constant care.

We can keep our hearts by consistently doing several things...

1) Bible study – Putting the Word of God inside of us will help keep the weeds of bad attitudes and laziness away from us. We all will be filled with something...either the things of God or the things of the world.

2) Prayer – There is no substitute for prayer today. We'll never be anything for God in public until we are first with God in private.

3) Faithfulness to the House of God – Accountability is very important in this day we live. We need each other.
