The first "official" Memorial Day (It was called Decoration Day back then) was celebrated in 1868. I'm told that a group of women asked the War Department for permission to put flowers on the graves of soldiers buried at Arlington Cemetery. Permission was finally granted to do so, but a stern order was attached to the permission: No flowers were to be placed on the graves of the Confederate soldiers. The confederates were buried in a segregated section of the cemetery.

The ladies carried out their task and carefully followed their instructions. A crowd gathered for the commemoration at which General Grant gave a speech. But shortly after the ceremony concluded, they say a strong gust of wind blew through the cemetery... and the wind blew almost all the flowers into the Confederate section.

After that the separation was never repeated. Many believed that the wind had sent by the hand of God.

And yet, even though that event took place a mere 150 years ago, not only do many folks not know that Memorial Day was begun after the Civil War, but there are many who don't know that Memorial Day has since been set aside to honor the dead of all American wars since that date. It's like most of the nation has forgotten WHY Memorial Day was established.

We honor those this week who have given their life in the line of duty across all wars. We enjoy so many freedoms and so many wonderful opportunities in America today. It may not seem like a lot to many people today, but what we enjoy today is because of the men and women who sacrificed their lives for us in the past.
