From My Heart...



John 20:7 tells us that the napkin, which was placed over the face of Jesus, was not just thrown aside like the grave clothes. The Bible takes an entire verse to tell us that the napkin was neatly folded, and was placed at the head of that stony coffin.

In the Hebrew tradition of that day, the folded napkin had to do with the Master and Servant, and every Jewish boy knew this tradition. When the servant set the dinner table for the master, he made sure that it was exactly the way the master wanted it. The table was furnished perfectly, and then the servant would wait, just out of sight, until the master had finished eating, and the servant would not dare touch that table, until the master was finished.

Now if the master was done eating, he would rise from the table, wipe his fingers, his mouth, and clean his beard, and would wad up that napkin and toss it onto the table. The servant would then know to clear the table. For in those days, the wadded napkin meant, "I'm done". But if the master got up from the table, and folded his napkin, and laid it beside his plate, the servant would not dare touch the table, because the servant knew that the folded napkin meant, "I'm not finished yet." The folded napkin meant, "I'm coming back!"

What does all that mean for us? It means Jesus is coming back! There are so many signs that are pointing to the fact that it may not be long before He comes again. Whether or not He's coming back is not really the question today...He is coming back...that is settled. The real question is are you ready for Him to come back?

IS YOUR HEART IN A RIGHT RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD? Can you honestly say...this is between you and God...that if He came this morning you would be thrilled. Or would you secretly hope He might wait a while because there are things in your life that you know are not right with God. You feel like you need more time.

IS YOUR FAMILY IN A RIGHT RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD? I know it is personal and no one can truly know the heart, but there are some signs and evidences that a person is walking with God. If you have members of your family that show no evidence...what are you doing about it?

He's coming back...I believe it's soon! Don't waste any more precious time...

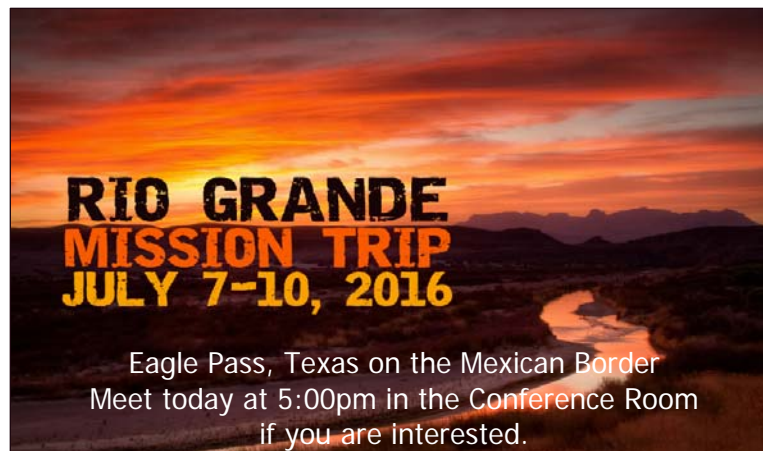
