FROM MY HEART...



Some of the most critical words Jesus ever spoke was not condemning the lost sinners or the reprobates on this earth. It was not to those who were opening living in sin or those who had bad habitual habits. It was not spoken to those who had addictions or those who had problems with self control. The most critical words Jesus spoke was to those who were religious, yet they were hypocrites.

In Matthew 23:12, Jesus said, "Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites, because you shut off the Kingdom of Heaven from people; for you do not enter in yourselves, nor do you allow those who are entering to go in." These men were doubly cursed, Jesus indicated: not only were THEY going to hell; but they were causing others to go there as well.

Jesus had previously said in Matthew 18 that it was better that a millstone to be hung around your neck, and to be drowned in the sea, than to cause one of these little ones to stumble. But these men DID put stumbling blocks in other peoples' way, which would keep them from heaven. Therefore their punishment would be very great.

This should greatly concern us today! We should be asking ourselves, "is there any way in which I myself am like these men, and am keeping people from the Kingdom of God? Is there anything in my lifestyle; the words I speak; my attitudes; which would keep someone from coming to the Lord?"

Remember the acrostic JOY...Jesus...Others...Yourself. Don't mix that up. Many put self above all others. We shouldn't live merely to please ourselves; we impact many others by what we say and do. And one of our prime considerations before we say or do anything should be how it might impact anyone's potential salvation.

Pray for Becky and me as we travel this week to Italy. We'll be gone next Sunday, but as always Bro. Kase will do a tremendous job of filling the pulpit. I'm looking forward to some days of just Becky and me...see you again, Lord willing, on October 8!
