## From My Heart...

Solomon wrote in Ecclesiastes, "Everything on earth has its own time and its seasons." Then he began to list all the different seasons that we face. Life has its seasons, and there are some seasons that will give you no indication that it's going to change. Some seasons of life are abrupt and some are gradual. Some seasons are short, but some seasons can last a long time.

The seasons of life can be when:

- There is more chaos than calmness.
- More trials than triumphs
- More struggles than strengths
- More darkness than the dawn
- More speculations than surety
- ° More, Oh God what's next, than Oh God thank you.
- Life has its season, its dry spells, its daily famine when it just seems that things are going from bad to worse.

What do you do when you find yourself in your personal and private season of dried brooks, and the absence of your raven that seems to have misplaced your address?

- We must remember that we are still God's child even in dry season and the absence of the raven. We are expected to behave as a believer when the brook dries up, and the raven is not showing up.
- We must be careful that we don't allow the season to dictate our behavior! Our behavior as a believer cannot be based on the season but on the sovereign will and way of God.
- We must stay close to God. When we get too far from God, we lose sight of him, and the farther we get from God, the smaller God appears. The problem is not the size of God, its where we're trying to see him from. When you get too far out there, you lose your taste for the church, and you lose your taste for God. Your appetite changes for something else!
