

SERMON NOTES

The High Cost of Following Christ!

Sermon Notes

Luke 9:23–26 And he said to all, "If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me. For whoever would save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will save it. For what does it profit a man if he gains the whole world and loses or forfeits himself?

- In what ways have you seen churches take a 'consumer driven' mindset?
- In what ways have some modern evangelicals changed the message of Christ and Salvation in order to make it more 'appealing.'

1. DENY YOURSELF

Lord, high and holy, meek and lowly, let me learn by paradox that the way down is the way up, that to be low is to be high, that the broken heart is the healed heart, that the contrite spirit is the rejoicing spirit, that the repenting soul is the victorious soul, that to have nothing is to possess everything, that to bear the cross is to wear the crown, that to give is to receive. Let me find thy light in my darkness, thy joy in my sorrow, thy grace in my sin, thy riches in my poverty, thy glory in my valley, thy life in my death.

- "Deny" means to 'refuse to associate with,' what are some things in your life that you need to refuse to associate with any longer?
- In what ways are you like the 'rich young ruler' of Mark 10?

2. TAKE UP YOUR CROSS DAILY

Matthew 10:38–39 And whoever does not take his cross and follow me is not worthy of me. Whoever finds his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for my sake will find it.

• In what ways can we 'take up our cross daily?

Romans 12:1–2 I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.

• What would it look like to be a 'living sacrifice?'

3. FOLLOW JESUS

Matthew 4:19 And he said to them, "Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men."

- What did the disciples give up once they decided to follow Jesus?
- What are some things you have had to give up/ or need to give up in order to fully follow Jesus?

Matthew 7:13–14 "Enter by the narrow gate. For the gate is wide and the way is easy that leads to destruction, and those who enter by it are many. For the gate is narrow and the way is hard that leads to life, and those who find it are few.

Being a follower of Jesus is not a guarantee of 'health, wealth, and prosperity' in this life, it very well could be the most difficult thing you ever do. But can I just assure you my friends it is WORTH IT!
