I was reading an article from an atheist this week, Daniel Finke. He was giving advice to believers on how to witness. He used to be a Christian (he says) but I found his answers to be intriguing. Here are his top points of advice...

1...*Be like Jesus: Hang with the sinners and judge the judges*

2...*Form genuine relationships with people, don't treat them as projects*

3...*Actions speak louder than words*

4...*When talking about religious matters, ask more questions and do less preaching*

5...*Don't give unsolicited advice or judgements. Support people and wait for them to ask for your input if they want it*

6...*Don't try to force others into Christian participation*

7...*Respect other religions even as you evangelize their members*

8...*Love your enemies, not just your tribe*

Any form of witnessing must be prefaced by the power of the Holy Spirit. It's what the world calls, "being in the right place at the right time." It's what we believers call "being led by the Holy Spirit of God."

BLESSED HOPE SUNDAY WELCOME BRO. JIM MOSS

Evangelist Jim W. Moss was born in Pine Bluff, Arkansas and called to preach at the age of 14. At the age of 18, he became pastor of the Macedonia Baptist Church in Humnoke, Arkansas. In 1978 and 1979, Macedonia was the fastest growing church in Arkansas with over 250 baptisms recorded. God moved him to Ephesus Baptist Church in 1981, then in 1990 and for the next 10 years First Baptist Church, San Augustine. Both churches received recognitions for the largest percentage Sunday School growth and twenty percent baptism increase. For the past 16 years Brother Moss surrendered to the call of evangelism. At the outset, he acknowledged that accountability was of utmost importance to God and the people who supported him, thus, his Love Worth Sharing Evangelistic Ministries became incorporated. He graduated and received a Bachelor of Arts Degree from Louisiana Baptist University. In December 2015, Jim was awarded a prestigious honorary Doctor of Ministry from Temple Baptist Seminary for his 41 years of dedication to the Gospel Ministry. Jim is married to Rita McClellan of New Edinburg, Arkansas. They have two grown children, Jeremiah Moss and Geneva Moss Brown; a daughter-in-law, Amanda May Moss and son-in-law, Waylon Brown; and six grandchildren. Bro. Jim resides in Nacogdoches, Texas.
