FROM MY HEART...



Victor Frankl wrote, "We who lived in concentration camps can remember the men who walked through the huts comforting others, giving away their last piece of bread. They may have been few in number, but they offer sufficient proof that everything can be taken from a man but one thing: the last of the human freedoms -- to choose one's attitude in any given set of circumstances, to choose one's own way."

Think of all the things we can't control: how many show up on Sunday, who comes to Christ, the decisions our children make, who has a heart attack, who has cancer, our income, and there are untold others. We may have some influence over these things, but we don't have complete control.

The one thing we can control is how we will respond to the situations we face. We can face these situations with anger, doubt, and self-pity; or we can face these situations with faith, hope, and love.

In the Psalms we encounter David in difficult situations -- surrounded by enemies, struggling with sin, sinking in despair -- and again and again we see his absolute resolve to think right: *"Why art thou cast down, O my soul? and why art thou disquieted within me? hope in God: for I shall yet praise him, who is the health of my countenance, and my God."* (Psalm 43:5)

We can't control what happens today, but we can control our actions. Let's not let our situations get the best of us today. The choice will be ours. With the help of Christ and the Holy Spirit, we are that kind of people. It will be the very thing that brings people to Christ.
