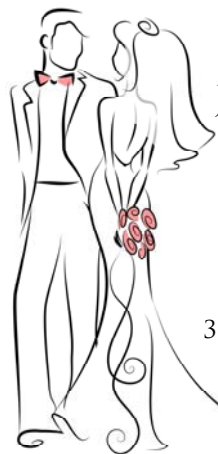

From My Heart...



My football career was less than impressive. I never actually started a game, but I did learn a secret about getting to play. The coach will sometimes send in the guy standing closest to him. It happens, for example, when someone has just been dragged off the field and he needs someone -- anyone -- to fill a spot.

I learned that if I was close enough at that moment, he just might choose me. It worked sometimes -- certainly more often than sulking on the bench would have. This is why, during the course of my single season of play, I entered the game as an offensive lineman, a wide receiver and a safety -- even though I never practiced in these positions. I usually didn't know exactly what I was expected to do, but at least I was on the field.

There's a principle here to remember: As Dwight L. Moody once said, "God always uses the man closest to him." Unlike my junior high coach, God isn't easily distracted and he doesn't send us anywhere unprepared. But he does use those who are eager to get into the game.

That's why I want to make a habit of "getting in God's way" so to speak, so that when he's ready to use someone, He sees me first. I want to always be in a position where God can do something with my life. "For the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to shew himself strong in the behalf of them whose heart is perfect toward him." 2 Chronicles 16:9

Isaiah heard God say, "Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?" And Isaiah responded, "Here am I. Send me!" (Isaiah 6:8)

God is asking the same question today. He's looking for those who are ready to be used in a great way. When he's searching the sidelines for someone to take the field, I want to be standing close to him.

Let me encourage you to take advantage of this time of the year... Christmas! People are searching and please be sensitive to sharing the good news of the gospel to those around you.

I'm excited about what God is going to do this Christmas season!
