Those who fifteen minutes earlier had refused to do more now either added their names to the list or increased their donations. 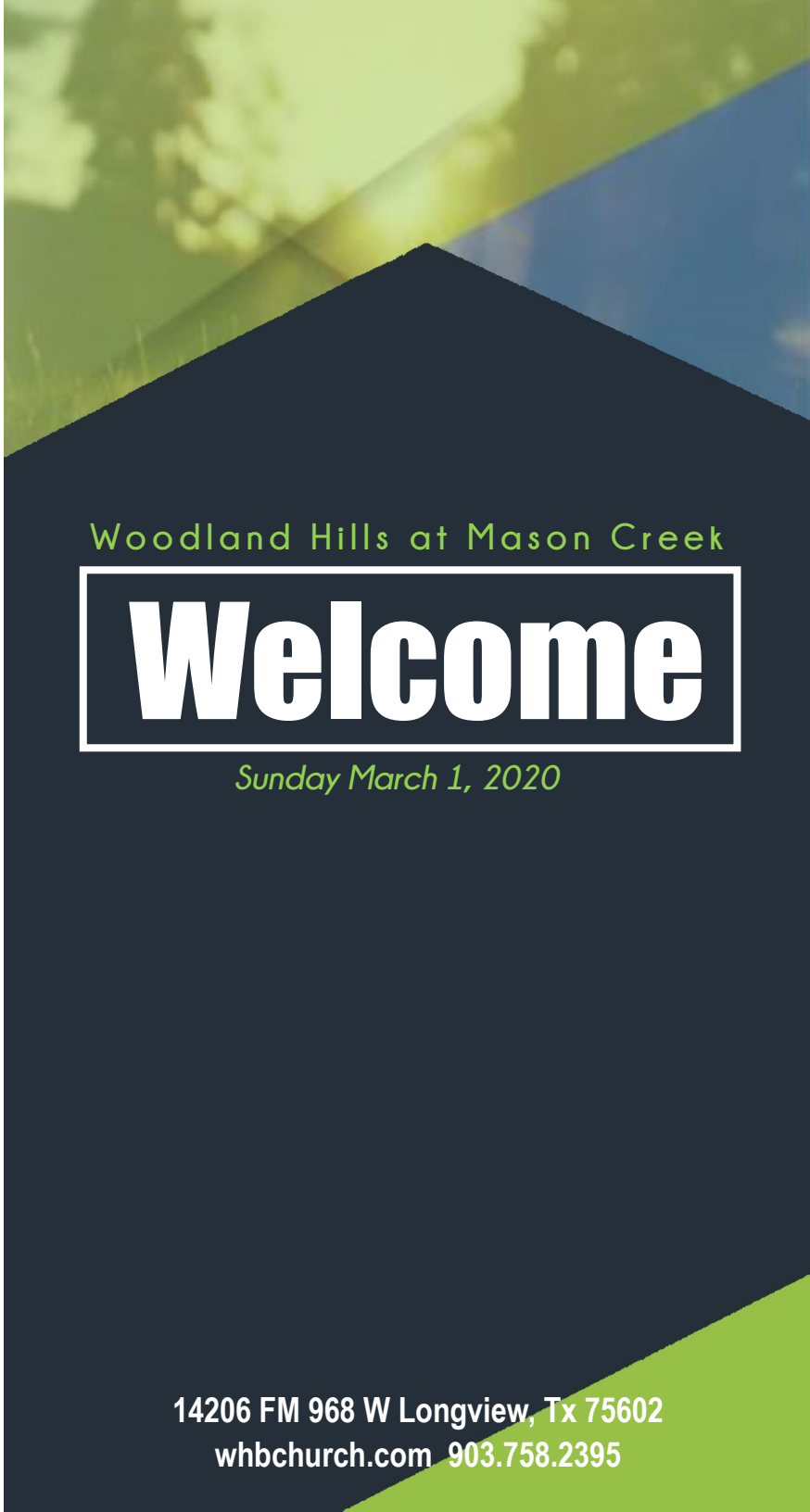
