As I reflect back on 2018 and get ready to storm into 2019, I'm reminded of what Robert Louis Stevenson once said, "The person who has stopped being thankful has fallen asleep in life." The Apostle Paul wrote in I Thessalonians 5:18, "In everything give thanks for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you."

Bob laughed and told him, no, he wasn't rich.

Bob recalled, "Then he asked if we owned an automobile and I told him we had two cars in our family. His next question was about the house where we lived. I told him it was a rather simple house with ten rooms. He was amazed at its size, especially when he related that he and his family lived in just two small rooms." "Then he asked about our family. We told him we had four healthy children, two in college and two still at home. Joseph was silent for a moment or so, and then he replied, 'You are a rich man.' We laughed, but deep in our hearts we knew he was right, though we had never thought of it in those terms. We were rich. But were we thankful?"
