

From My Heart...

William Barclay tells a story about the ancient Greek city of Sparta and then drives the point home with a striking application.

There is a famous story from Sparta. A Spartan king boasted to a visiting monarch about the walls of Sparta. The visiting monarch looked around and he could see no walls. He said to the Spartan king, "Where are these walls about which you speak and boast so much?" The Spartan king pointed at his bodyguard of magnificent Spartan troops. "These," he said, "are the walls of Sparta, and every man of them a brick."

Now, the point is quite clear. So long as a brick lies by itself it is useless. It only becomes of use when it is built into a building. That is why it was made; and it is in being built into a building that it realizes its function and the reason for its existence.

It is so with the individual Christian. To realize our destiny, we must not remain alone, but we must be built into the fabric and edifice of the Church. It is vitally important to our very life. "He is the vine and we are the branches." When the branch is separated from the vine, it doesn't hurt the vine that much...but it destroys the branch. When you are separated from the church, the church will not be crippled and stop moving. God's work will carry on. The problem is you will end up dying...you will be destroyed.
