

Victor Frankl wrote, "We who lived in concentration camps can remember the men who walked through the huts comforting others, giving away their last piece of bread. They may have been few in number, but they offer sufficient proof that everything can be taken from a man but one thing: the last of the human freedoms -- to choose one's attitude in any given set of circumstances, to choose one's own way."

Think of all the things we cannot control. For example, how many show up on Sunday, who comes to Christ, the decisions our children make, our health, our income, and there are untold others that we cannot control. We may have some influence over these things, but we don't have complete control.

The one thing we can control is how we will respond to the situations we face. With anger, doubt, and self-pity ... or with faith, hope, and love.


