From my heart

To feel bound by perceived limits is so human, so common. A century ago there were predictions that no one could ever drive a car 60 miles per hour because the wind would suck one's breath away. In 1934 the track coach at the University of California laid out what he believed were the absolute limits of achievement in track and field events. All of them, of course, have long since been exceeded. High school athletes today are out-performing Olympic champions of a few decades ago. There appears to be no limit to how fast we can run, how far we can go, how high we can leap.

The world's most famous evangelist D.L. Moody was hosting a Bible Conference in Massachusetts in the late 1800s. Many of the participants came from Europe. Following the European custom of the time, they left their shoes outside their room to be cleaned by the hall servants overnight. They did not know that there were no hall servants in America. Walking down the dormitory halls that night, Moody noticed the shoes and determined not to embarrass his guests. He gathered up the shoes, went to his room and began to clean and polish the shoes. Only the unexpected arrival of a friend in the midst of the work revealed the secret. The following morning the foreign visitors opened their doors and found their shoes shined. They did not know by whom. Moody told no one, but his friend told a few people, and during the rest of the conference, a different person volunteered to shine the shoes in secret each night.

God has blessed us with a great staff to carry forth the word of the Lord in this area. I praise God for them. God has given us some great men, we call them deacons, who know they are servants of the Most High God...and they will serve faithfully in the future. I believe God has given us men who will stay up late at night "polishing shoes" or anything else that is necessary for the glory of God! It is a great blessing to work with men like this.

We've seen God do some marvelous things at Woodland Hills...I believe with all my heart there is no limit to what God wants to do and will do. Thank God for our staff and for our deacons...BUT they do not take the place of other committed Christians. I praise God for each member that is working in some various form of ministry! I look forward to all of us working together and with each other as we serve the Lord together in the years ahead.
