

There's a verse in Ecclesiastes that says, "So I saw that there is nothing better for people than to be happy in their work. That is why we are here!" (Ecclesiastes 3:21)

Solomon didn't say, "There is nothing better for people than to have work that makes them happy." The emphasis is on you being happy in your work, not on your work making you happy. Wow! That's a whole new way to look at work!

I see people on a regular basis that get bored, distressed and frustrated over what I consider to be great jobs! I see others approach the most mundane jobs with passion and enthusiasm. Keep in mind in the middle of everything we do, that everything being done is for the glory of God and to see that people are prepared for the coming Lord. The lives of children, youth and adults will be changed for eternity because of your cooperation and your mind to work and minister. Many churches shut everything down during the summer...you have revved it up! Everybody will spend eternity somewhere. There are only two places, and we need to do everything within our power to make sure as many choose heaven as possible.

Every person is very important in the Kingdom of God at Woodland Hills at Mason Creek. We could not do it without you! Keep it up!!!
